Sessions Overview

Master Handling

This session will include full course work at a Master level with the possibility of contacts and weaves. Dogs should know all the obstacles and handlers have a knowledge of most crosses.

Young Dogs / Foundations

Building obstacle commitment and perfecting crosses and proofing foundations for agility. Skills will be put together into short sequences.

International Handling

This session will include full courses at an International level, with the possibility of contacts and weaves. Dogs should know all the obstacles, and handlers have a knowledge of all crosses and backsides.

Proofing

This session will include short sequences to test and improve the dogs understanding of the equipment, with the possibility of contacts and weaves. Dogs should know all the obstacles, and handlers should know most of the

Handling Skills and Drills

This session will include sequences with jumps and tunnels. Dogs and handlers should have a basic knowledge of all crosses. Variations of each sequence will be ran to determine what works for each team to create the fastest, smoothest lines.
